The initiative is in active planning and execution across 21 academic units.

## Progress to date

- **MiWorkspace:** 12 Kickoffs & 33 Training Sessions completed to support unit transitions.
- **MiServices (Server & Compute):** Service migrations active; ongoing engagement with Unit Leadership.
- **Network:** Upgrades initiated for VPN and Firewall infrastructure.
- **Security:** 38,000+ faculty/staff completed training across 3 campuses.
- **Vulnerability Mgmt:** Enhanced reporting and updated standard protocols in progress.
- **IT Exceptions:** Streamlined MVP process launched for faster management.
